- Born 1924 in Trebinje, Bosnia and Herzegovina;
- He is an engineer of agriculture, a doctor of science – specialist in soil sciences, and a university professor;
- He works as an advisor at the Institute of Agropedology in Sarajevo;
- He was the President of Yugoslav Soil Science Society;
- He was the Manager of the Institute for Soil Sciences and on the Faculty of Agriculture in Sarajevo;
- He received a doctors degree from the Faculty of Agriculture in Beograd, 1964;
- He has spent his entire career working for the Agricultural Faculty in Sarajevo—working his way up from an assistant to assistant professor, as a docent, and from an ordinary professor to full (tenured) Professor;
- He received the National State Prize for his scientific work entitled: “27th of July;”
- He has published 150 scientific papers, and 10 textbooks;
- He participates in many scientific symposiums and congresses and has submitted scientific reports in many countries;
- He has been a mentor to 14 doctoral candidates and 16 masters degree candidates;
- He has written textbooks for students: *Pedology* (2002), *Soil Classification* (2008), *Ecological and Technical Soil Functions* (1990) and *Soil Physics* (1998);
- His expertise is in: soil classifications, soil physics, soil damages and soil protection.
